





• B. It's All about **Abiding** - How

1. Built on an Already
Established Status —
"In Me, I in You" v. 4



Identifying the Principal PRINCIPLE

2. Built up Through an Ongoing **Intimate** Relationship

a. Keep His Commandments – His Words To Me & In Me

His Last Command is to "Teach converts to obey all that He commanded." Jesus does the same (14:31); 1 John 5:2-3

b. Keeping His Words = **Abiding in His Love**, v.10

 Prove they are also <u>Disciples</u>



A Final Proof to Ponder, 2 Peter 1

- Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord;
- seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence.
- 4 For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of *the* divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.



A Final Proof to Ponder, 2 Peter 1

- Now for this very reason also, <u>applying all diligence</u>, in your **faith** supply [add] moral excellence, and in *your* moral excellence, knowledge,
- 6 and in your knowledge, self-control, and in your self-control, perseverance, and in your perseverance, godliness,
- 7 and in *your* godliness, brotherly kindness,

and in *your* brotherly kindness, **love.**



A Final Proof to Ponder, 2 Peter 1

- 8 For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they render you neither useless nor unfruitful in the true knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 9 For he who lacks [not abiding] these qualities is blind or short-sighted, having forgotten his purification from his former sins.
- 10 Therefore, brethren, be all the more diligent to make certain about His calling and choosing you; for as long as you <u>practice</u> these things, you will never stumble;
- 11 for in this way the entrance into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ will be <u>abundantly supplied</u> to you.
