


I. His Glory, vv. 1-5

- A. His and The Father's
- 1. Glory "weight" "the uniquely honorable attributes of a person or thing that are weighty and recognizable to the extent that they leave a powerful impression." ["glory" or "glorify" appears 8 times]

 B. This is an Accounting of His (Jesus') Stewardship [word "given" or "gavest" appears 14 times



II. His Guys, vv. 6-19

A. What Jesus did for Them

- 1. He Manifested the Father's Name to Them, v.6
- 2. He Gave Them the Father's Words, v. 8
- 3. He Kept Them in the Father's Name, v. 12
- 4. He Sanctified Himself for Them, v. 19

II. His Guys, vv. 6-19

• B. How They Responded

1. Kept His Words, v. 6

Came to Know that **Everything** of Christ's Came from the Father, v. 7

3. Have Received, Understood, and Believed, v.8

II. His Guys, vv. 6-19

- C. What He Requests The Father Do for Them
 - 1. Keep them in Your Name...so they may be One v. 11
 - 2. Keep them from The Evil One, v. 15
 - 3. Sanctify them in the Truth, v. 17

 ("for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they themselves may be sanctified in truth", cp. 1 Tim 4:14-16; 2 Tim. 2:20-21)

B. His Requests for Us

1. That We May Be One...

...so that they would be in Us...so that the World may Believe, v.21

III. His Generations to Come, vv. 20-26

- B. His Requests for Us
 - Our Glory Would be Like His Glory...Unity with Father and Son ...that we might be perfected (matured) in unity ...that the World would know Jesus came from the Father and Loves Them, vv. 22-23
 - 3. That We Would be With Him to See His Glory, v. 24
