2 Corinthians 9:7

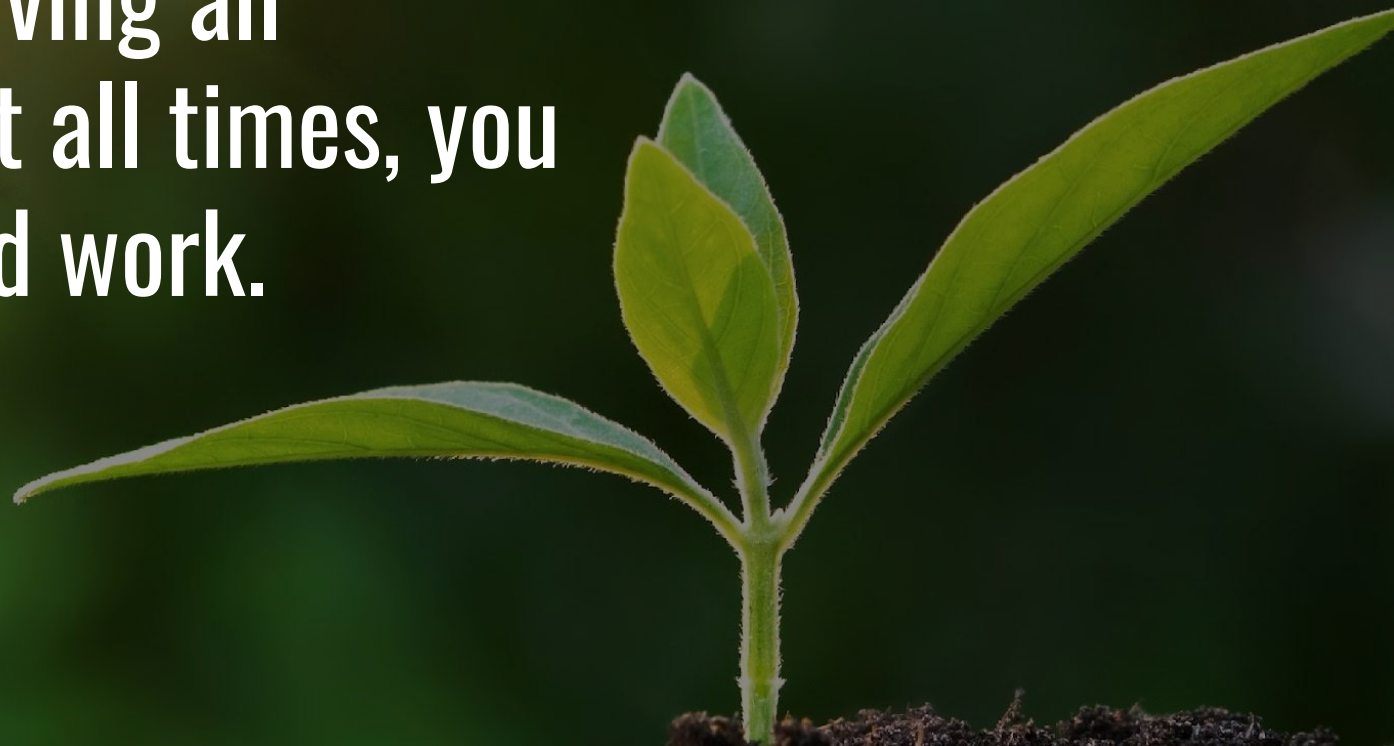

may abound in every good work.

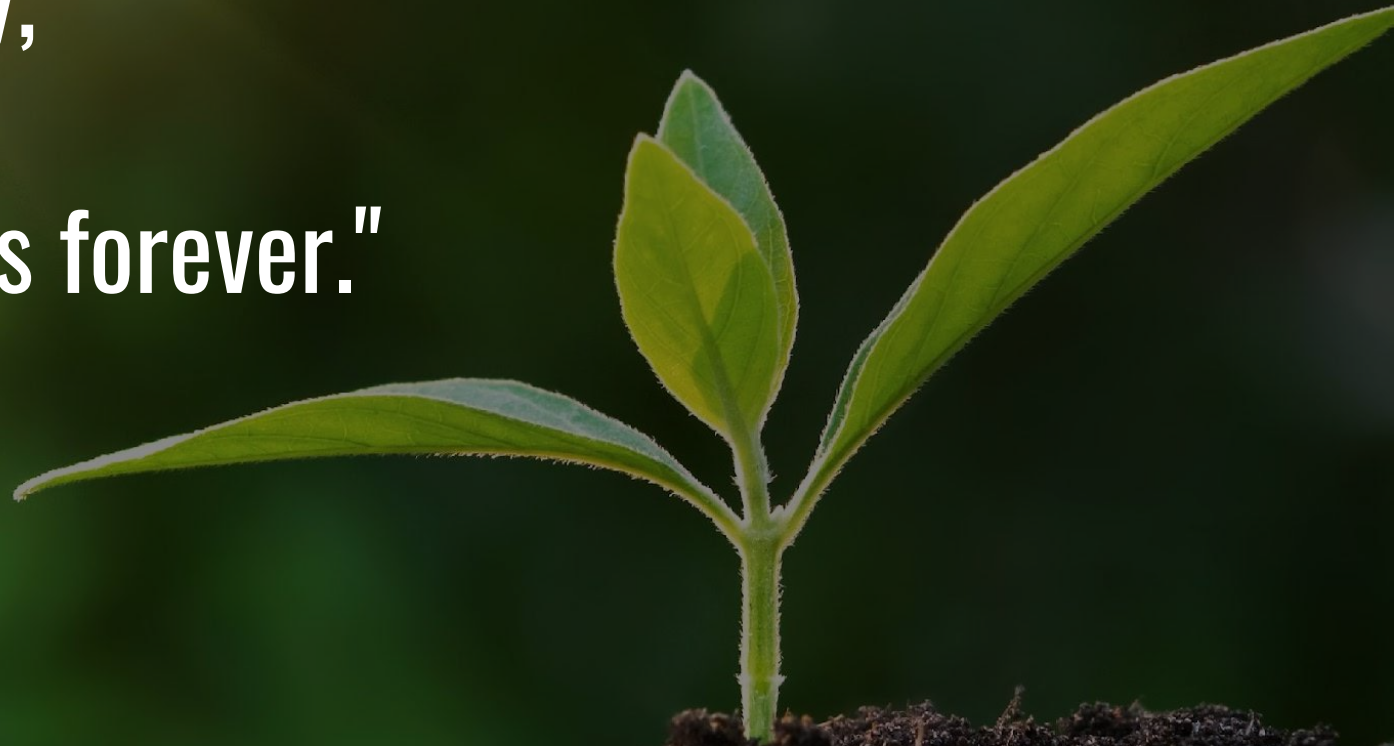
