

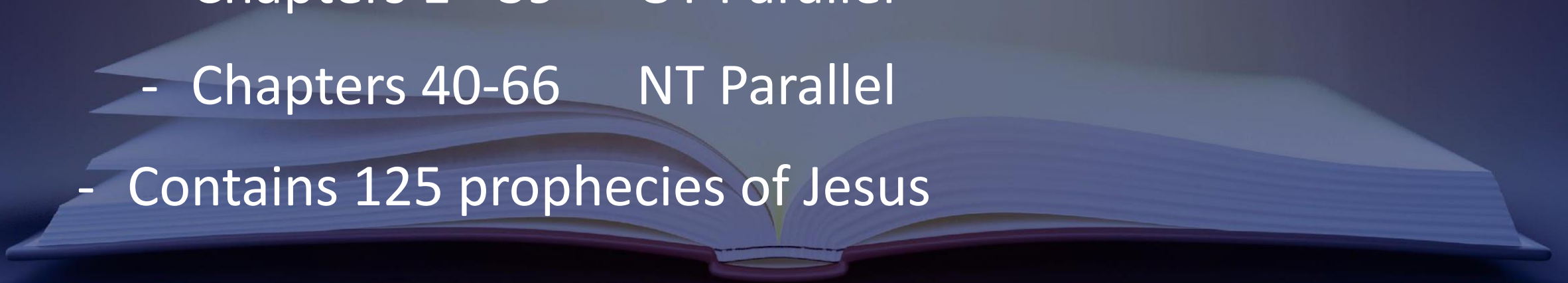

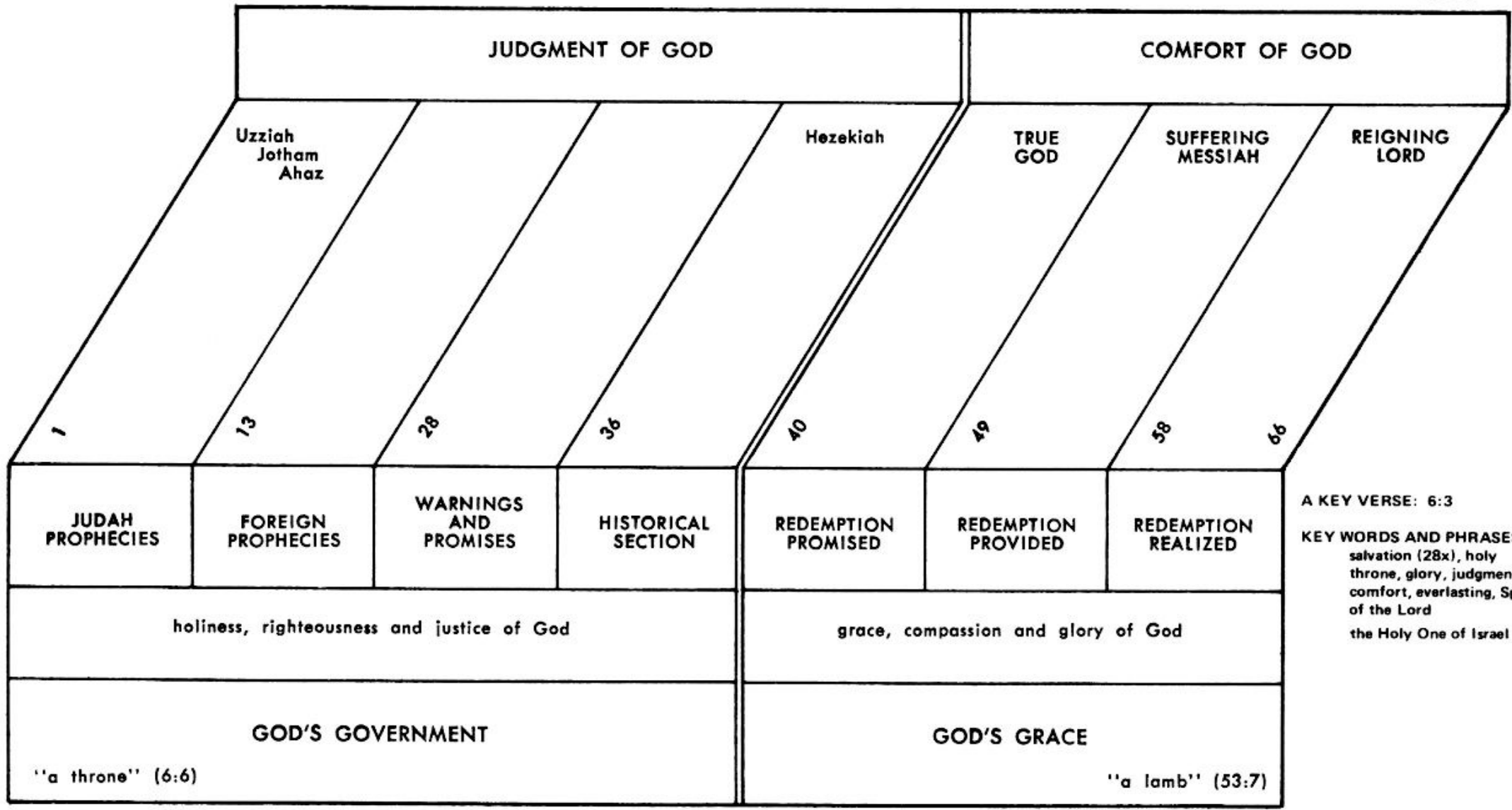

- Contains 125 prophecies of Jesus

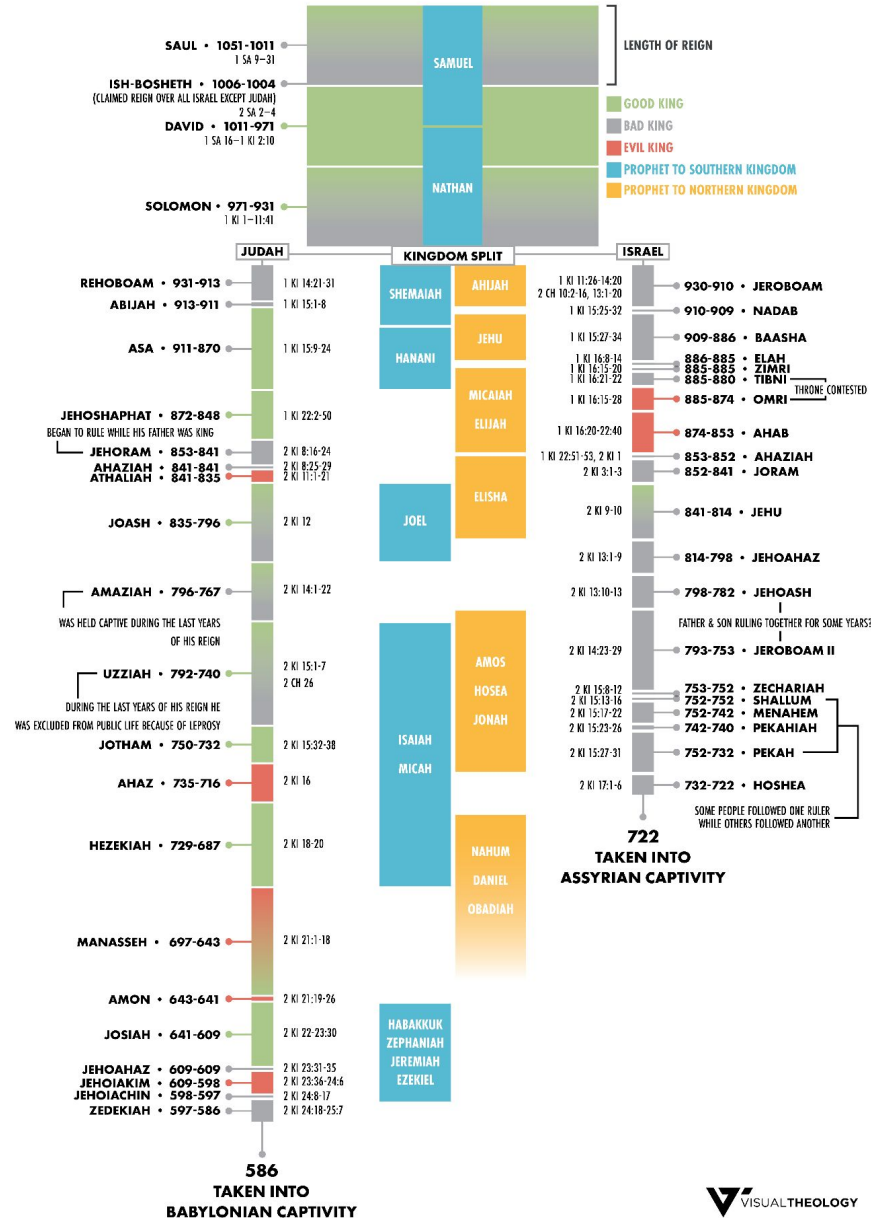


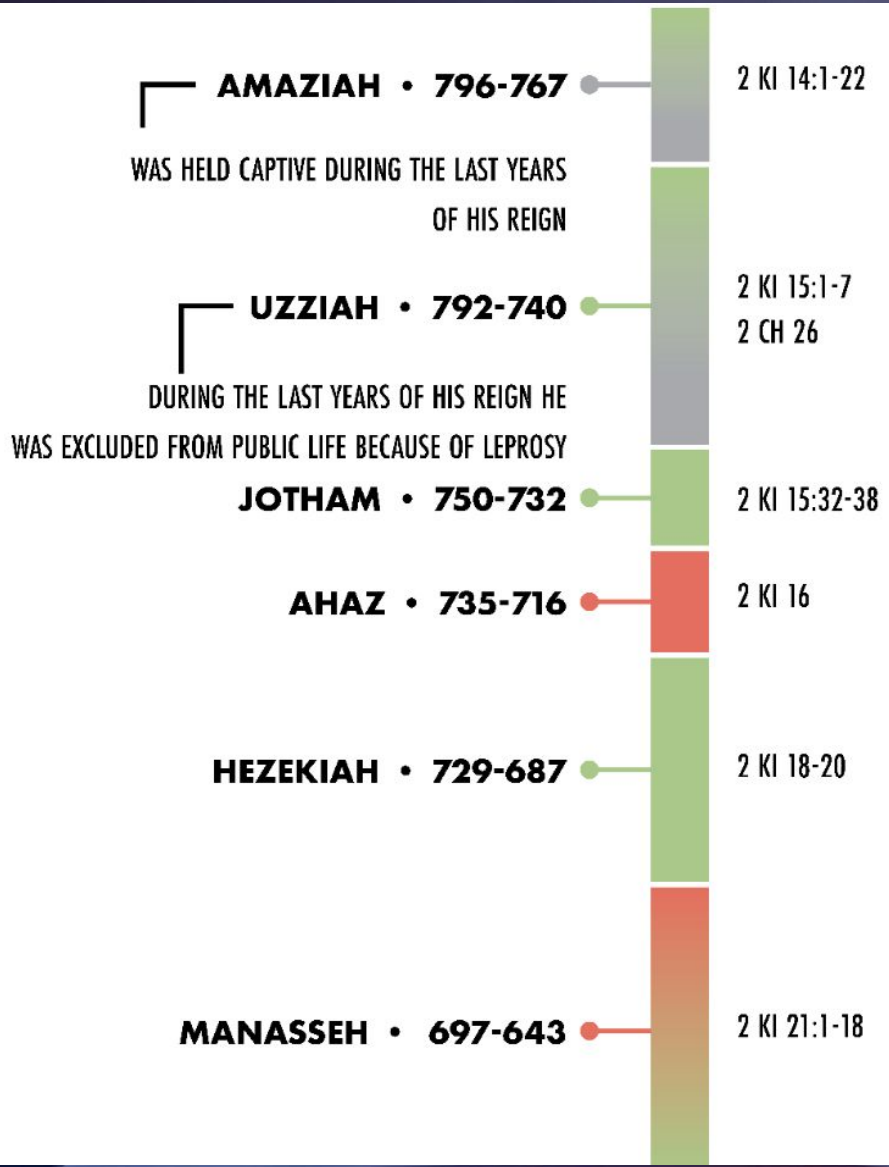
