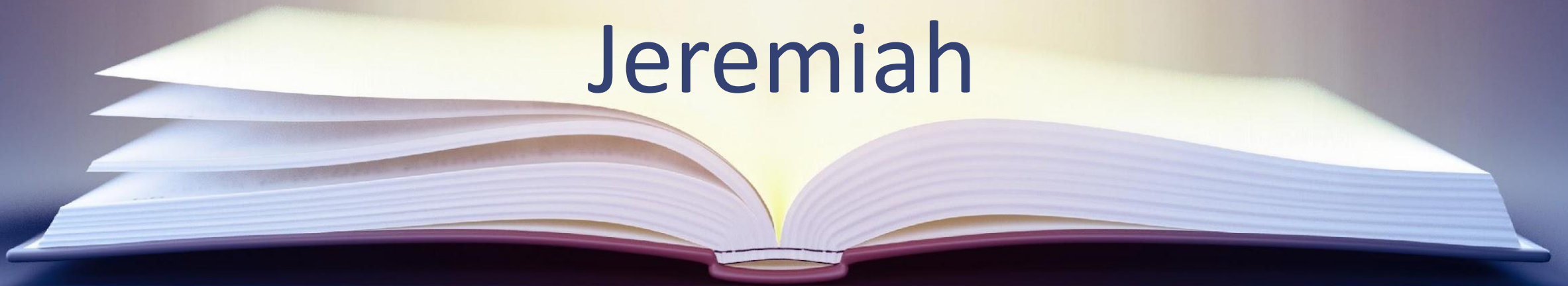

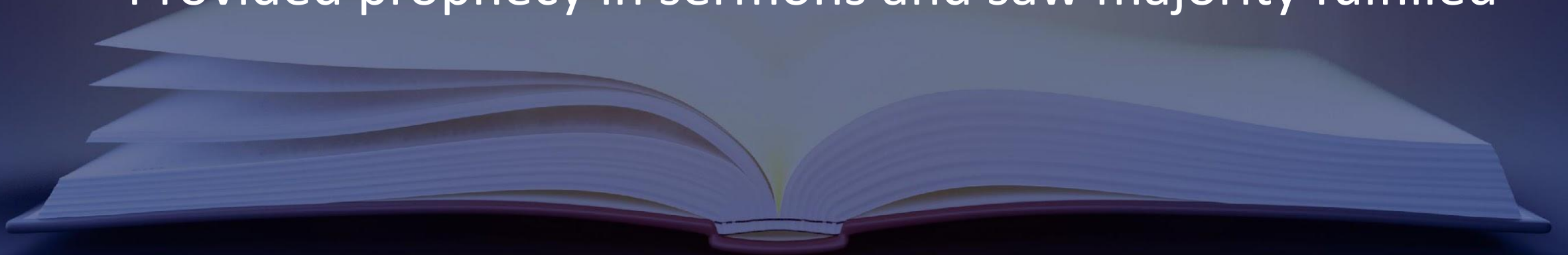


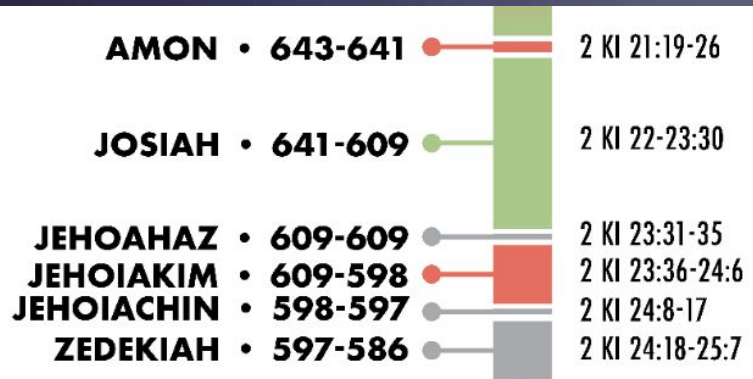

Jeremiah 7:1-2

Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Amend your ways and your deeds, and I will let you dwell in this place.

Do not trust in these deceptive words: 'This is the temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD.'

"For if you truly amend your ways and your deeds, if you truly execute justice one with another, if you do not oppress the sojourner, the fatherless, or the widow, or shed innocent blood in this place, and if you do not go after other gods to your own harm,

Jeremiah 7:5-6

then I will let you dwell in this place, in the land that I gave of old to your fathers forever.

"Behold, you trust in deceptive words to no avail.

Will you steal, murder, commit adultery, swear falsely, make offerings to Baal, and go after other gods that you have not known,

and then come and stand before me in this house,
which is called by my name, and say, 'We are
delivered!'--only to go on doing all these abominations?
Has this house, which is called by my name, become a
den of robbers in your eyes? Behold, I myself have
seen it, declares the LORD.

Judah in Idolatry

(Ch 7 - 10)

They bend their tongue like a bow; falsehood and not truth has grown strong in the land; for they proceed from evil to evil, and they do not know me, declares the LORD.



Jeremiah 9:3

Let everyone beware of his neighbor, and put no trust in any brother, for every brother is a deceiver, and every neighbor goes about as a slanderer.

Everyone deceives his neighbor, and no one speaks the truth; they have taught their tongue to speak lies; they weary themselves committing iniquity.



Thus says the LORD: "Let not the wise man boast in his wisdom, let not the mighty man boast in his might, let not the rich man boast in his riches, but let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth.

For in these things I delight, declares the LORD."

For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Do not let your prophets and your diviners who are among you deceive you, and do not listen to the dreams that they dream, for it is a lie that they are prophesying to you in My name; I did not send them, declares the LORD.

Jeremiah 29:8-9

"For thus says the LORD: When seventy years are completed for Babylon, I will visit you, and I will fulfill to you My promise and bring you back to this place.

For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Jeremiah 29:10-11

Then you will call upon Me and come and pray to Me,
and I will hear you.

You will seek Me and find Me, when you seek Me with
all your heart.



Jeremiah 29:12-13

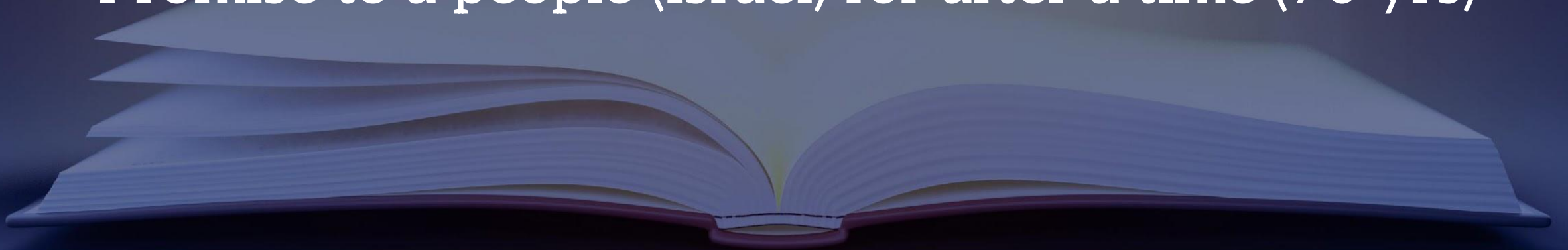
I will be found by you, declares the LORD, and I will restore your fortunes and gather you from all the nations and all the places where I have driven you, declares the LORD, and I will bring you back to the place from which I sent you into exile.

Judah in Opposition

(Ch 26 - 29)

- Beware of false teachings!
- His character and plan are consistent and sovereign
 - Peace, Future, and Hope
 - “When you seek Me with all your heart”
- Promise to a people (Israel) for after a time (70 yrs)



Before the Fall

(Ch 34 - 36)

In the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, king of Judah, this word came to Jeremiah from the LORD:
"Take a scroll and write on it all the words that I have spoken to you against Israel and Judah and all the nations, from the day I spoke to you, from the days of Josiah until today.

Jeremiah 36:1-2

Before the Fall

(Ch 34 - 36)

It may be that the house of Judah will hear all the disaster that I intend to do to them, so that every one may turn from his evil way, and that I may forgive their iniquity and their sin."

Before the Fall

(Ch 34 - 36)

As Jehudi read three or four columns, the king would cut them off with a knife and throw them into the fire in the fire pot, until the entire scroll was consumed in the fire that was in the fire pot. Yet neither the king nor any of his servants who heard all these words was afraid, nor did they tear their garments.

Jeremiah 36:23-24

Before the Fall

(Ch 34 - 36)

Now after the king had burned the scroll with the words that Baruch wrote at Jeremiah's dictation, the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah:

"Take another scroll and write on it all the former words that were in the first scroll, which Jehoiakim the king of Judah has burned.

Jeremiah 36:27-28

Before the Fall

(Ch 34 - 36)

And I will punish him and his offspring and his servants for their iniquity. I will bring upon them and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem and upon the people of Judah all the disaster that I have pronounced against them, but they would not hear."

Jeremiah 36:31

Before the Fall

(Ch 34 - 36)

- God continued to provide opportunities
 - Forgiveness & restoration
- Man relied on their own thoughts and plan
 - Live forever & control everything
- God's Word overcomes oppression
 - Omnipotent & Omniscient



After the Fall

(Ch 40 - 45)

then hear the word of the LORD, O remnant of Judah. Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: If you set your faces to enter Egypt and go to live there, then the sword that you fear shall overtake you there in the land of Egypt, and the famine of which you are afraid shall follow close after you to Egypt, and there you shall die.

Jeremiah 42:15-16

After the Fall

(Ch 40 - 45)

and say to them, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Behold, I will send and take Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and I will set his throne above these stones that I have hidden, and he will spread his royal canopy over them.

Jeremiah 43:10

After the Fall

(Ch 40 - 45)

- Even still God provide a means
 - God's Redemption is possible through obedience
- Man's heart is hardened
 - Continual choosing own path
- Man can not escape judgment
 - God is omnipresent



Hope against Judgment

(Ch 30 - 33)

"Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when **I will make a new covenant** with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the LORD.

Jeremiah 31:31-32

Hope against Judgment

(Ch 30 - 33)

For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put My law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be My people.



Jeremiah 31:33
