












Did Israel learn its lesson?

Short-term Solution - Restore Passion

"Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in My Temple. If you do," says the LORD of Heaven's Armies, "I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test!

Short-term Solution - Restore Passion

What is the symptom of your hard heart?

"Look! I am sending My messenger, and he will prepare the way before Me. Then the Lord you are seeking will suddenly come to His Temple. The messenger of the covenant, whom you look for so eagerly, is surely coming," says the LORD of Heaven's Armies.

"But who will be able to endure it when He comes? Who will be able to stand and face Him when He appears?

Messengers: <u>Malachi</u>, Elijah, <u>John the Baptist</u>

Prophecy of <u>First</u> and <u>Second Coming</u>

 Mystery of the Gospel = Jesus' mission as a suffering servant was hidden to the Jews

 Golden Thread is a <u>prophecy</u> that links the Old Testament to Jesus' earthly life AND to His second coming.

"Look, I am sending you the prophet <u>Elijah</u> before the great and dreadful day of the LORD arrives. His preaching will turn the hearts of fathers to their children, and the hearts of children to their fathers. Otherwise I will come and strike the land with a curse."

John the Baptiser - three perspectives

Jews - corruption, <u>hypocrisy</u>, looking for political leader

John - understood the motives of the Pharisees, and wanted to shift <u>focus</u> to Jesus.

Jesus - understood the present reality and <u>future</u> fulfilment.
