




Facts about the Book of John - Authorship

- Disciple, one of Jesus' inner circle, leader
- Wrote several epistles and <u>Revelation</u>
- One of the longest living eyewitnesses
- Mentor of Polycarp, 2nd century Church father

- Matthew, Mark, Luke are <u>Synoptic</u> Gospels
- Synoptic = sharing a similar viewpoint




- Matthew, Mark, Luke are Synoptic Gospels
- Synoptic = sharing a similar viewpoint
- Controversy
 - Similarities between synoptics are bad
 - John's uniqueness is also bad

• It was written by a different man.

In a different <u>decade</u> of the first century.

• For a different <u>purpose</u>.

The Four Gospels <u>Supplement</u> One another



The Four Gospels Supplement One another

There is <u>variation</u> in content and purpose.

 Just as you would expect from four different eyewitnesses to a common event.

Blessing to the nations

"For God loved the world in this way: He gave His One and Only Son, so that <u>everyone</u> who believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life.

John 3:16

Revelation of <u>new</u> relationship

"But in fact, it is best for you that I go away, because if I don't, the Advocate won't come. If I do go away, <u>then</u> I will send Him to you.

Insight into Jesus relationship with the Father

Jesus <u>claimed</u> equality with God

"So the Jewish leaders tried all the harder to find a way to kill Him. For He not only broke the Sabbath, He called God His Father, thereby making Himself <u>equal</u> with God."

John 5:18

Jesus revealed the role of the Holy Spirit

Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, before Abraham was even born, <u>I AM</u>!

John 8:58

Jesus revealed the nature of the Holy Spirit

"If you love Me, obey My commandments. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you. He is the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, who leads into all truth..."

John 14:15-17

Jesus clarifies the concept of the Trinity

But when the Father sends the Advocate as My representative—that is, the Holy Spirit—He will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you.

John 14:26

I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to Me will never be <u>hungry</u> again. Whoever believes in Me will never be

John 6:35

Unity based on the <u>unity</u> of the Godhead

Now I am departing from the world; they are staying in this world, but I am coming to you. Holy Father, You have given Me Your name; now protect them by the power of Your name so that they will be <u>united</u> just as We are.

John 17:11

Under the old covenant, the priest stands and ministers before the altar day after day, offering the same sacrifices again and again, which can never take away

sins.

Hebrews 10:11

But our High Priest offered Himself to God as a single sacrifice for sins, good for all time. Then He sat down in the place of honor at God's right hand.

Hebrews 10:12

And when sins have been forgiven, there is no need to offer any more sacrifices. And so, dear brothers and sisters, we can boldly enter heaven's Most Holy Place because of the blood of Jesus.

Hebrews 10:18-19

By His death, Jesus opened a new and life-giving way through the curtain into the Most Holy Place. And since we have a great High Priest who rules over God's house,

Hebrews 10:20,21

...let us go right into the <u>presence</u> of God with sincere hearts fully trusting Him. For our guilty consciences have been sprinkled with Christ's blood to make us clean, and our bodies have been washed with pure water.

Hebrews 10:22

Implications for us - summary

- A unity of believers based on the unity of
 - Godhead

• Direct Access versus Observer.

The book of John shows us that:

- Jesus life, death and resurrection were a fulfillment of prophecy <u>AND</u> set the stage for the church age.
- He brought us into a <u>fundamentally</u> different relationship with the Father.
- We now have direct access to a <u>Holy</u> God.
