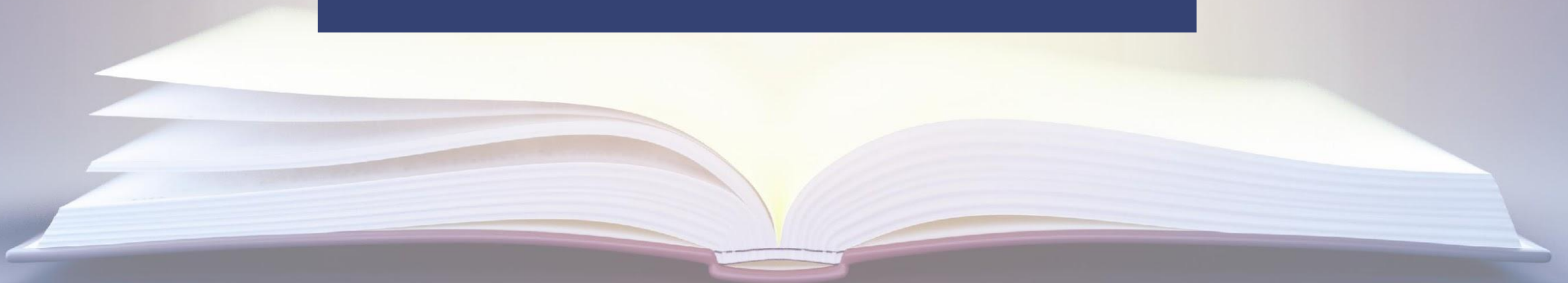
Foundation of Paul's Letter:

2. Identifies the abilities and standing that all Believers possess.



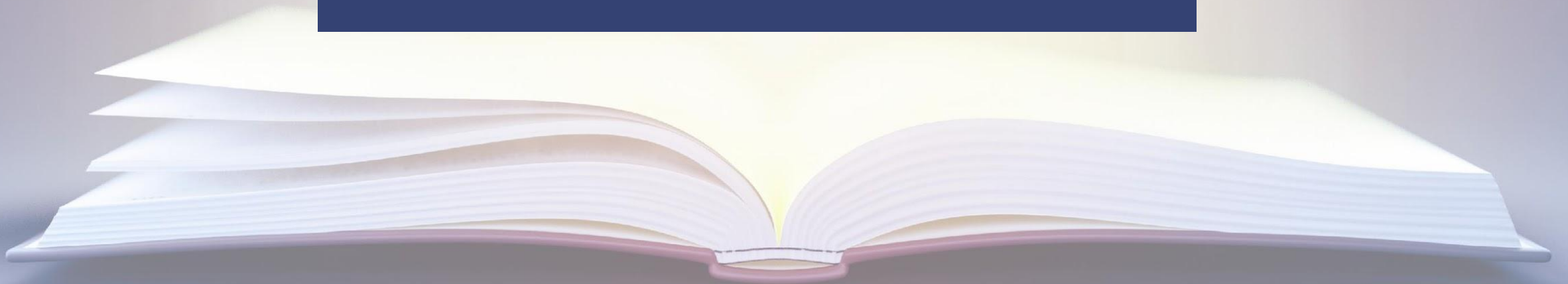
